IN RE: RECESS


The Chairman declared a brief recess at 8:45 p.m. The meeting reconvened at 9:00 p.m.

IN RE: BUDGET WORK SESSION -- 1991-92


The Board met in a workshop session to continue their work on the 1991-92 proposed budget.
