IN RE: CO-COMPOSTING PROPOSAL WORKSHOP

The Board of Supervisors met in a workshop session for discussion of the Co-Composting proposal presented by the Virginia Bio-Fuels Corporation.

The County Administrator opened the presentation and gave a brief review on the Co-composting Proposal.

Mr. Denny King, Director, Dinwiddie County Environmental Services, gave the past, current, and future requirements on the present landfill operation and the changing regulatory environment.

Mr. Ted Baxter, President, and Mr. Barry Funnell, Vice President, Virginia Bio-Fuels Corporation, gave a slide demonstration of the concept of co-composting and the proposed facility.

The County Administrator then presented the landfill versus co-composting, 30 year cost comparison.

Mr. Funnell, Mr. Baxter, Mr. King and the County Administrator covered the implementation of the permit process, schedule, contract, construction, operation, and personnel issues. Time was allotted for questions and answers from the public.
