IN RE: WORKSHOP SESSION -- VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
SIX-YEAR PLAN -- SECONDARY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Mr. Dale Goodman, Acting Resident Engineer, Mr. Harold Dyson, Assistant Resident Engineer, and Mr. Charles Gill, VDOT met in a workshop session with the Board to discuss revisions to the Six-Year Plan for Secondary Road Improvements.

Mr. Dyson stated the following projects were requested at the Public Hearing:

1. Rt. 703 - Williams Road - Pave existing road
2. Rt. 611 - Exter Mill Road - Recondition existing road
3. Rt. 615 - Blue Tartane Road - Pave existing road
4. Rt. 604 - Halifax Road - Recondition existing road
5. Rt. 725 - Cherokee Drive - Pave existing road
6. Rt. 624 - Coleman Lake Road - Recondition existing road

Mr. Dyson stated there was not enough money to fund the projects but the preliminary engineering could be done. He suggested adding at least one unpaved road to retain any monies the State passed down. He explained that if the County did not include the unpaved road it would lose the \$200,000 for unpaved road funds.


Mr. Bracey made the motion to leave the Six-Year Plan as is and add the following to the priority list:

1. Rt. 604 - Halifax Road From: Rt. F081 To: 1.32 miles S.  
Rt. F081 - pave existing road - Cost \$675,000
2. Rt. 624 Coleman Lake Road - From: Rt. 613 To: Rt. 460 3.80  
miles - recondition existing road - Cost \$1,600,000
3. Rt. 615 - Blue Tartane Road - From: Rt. F081 To: 1.32 miles S.  
Rt. 081 - pave existing road - Cost \$525,00

The motion was seconded by Mr. Haraway. Mr. Clay, Mr. Bracey, Mr. Haraway, Ms. Everett, voting "aye".
