IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salaries and accounts against the General Revenue Fund of the County for the month of November, 1961, amounting to \$7,703.53 be allowed and checks numbering 2085 through 2165, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the General Revenue Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered that the salary of \$208.33 be paid to the Dog Warden and that the claims amounting to \$554.96 be allowed, and checks numbering D-70 through D-76, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the Dog Fund of said County.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT, MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1961.

F. E. Jones, Treasurer having submitted a written financial report, same was ordered filed with the papers of the Board for the month of November.

IN RE: ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE - TREASURER'S OFFICE STATIONERY.

It appearing to the Board that the payment of September, 1961 expense vouchers for tax tickets has overdrawn the stationery account \$2.00,

Motion was duly made and carried that \$2.00 be allowed to take care of this overdraft.

IN RE: HEALTH CENTER BUILDING, BLINDS REPAIRED.

Bids having been requested for repairing six blinds in the Health Center building and it appearing that J. L. Kirkland, 420 Maycox Street, Petersburg, Virginia, submitted the low bid of \$10.00 each,

Motion was duly made and carried that six blinds be repaired for the sum of \$60.00.

IN RE: PLAT - J. HUNTER GLASS PROPERTY.

A plat of property purchased by J. Hunter Glass in the village of DeWitt having been presented for this Board's approval and same being approved by the Department of Health,

Motion was duly made and carried that this plat be approved and recorded in the Clerk's Office.

IN RE: SCHOOLS - CONSOLIDATION PETITIONS.

Petitions from Suburban Ladies Club of Namozine District and Junior Gerow Home Demonstration Club having been received in favor of consolidation of the Dinwiddie Schools,

Motion was made and carried that same be filed with the Board papers for this month.

IN RE: BUILDING PERMITS.

Mr. L. C. Harrison, Jr., County Sanitarian having suggested that the County building permits be approved by the Health Department prior to the approval by the Commissioner of Revenue,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Commissioner of Revenue revise his present building permit forms so as to include space for approval by the Department of Health of Dinwiddie County.

IN RE: ASSISTANT FARM AGENT REPORT.

Mr. Ernest Wrenn Assistant Farm Agent spoke before the Board giving an out-line of his work in the County.

IN RE: FINAL BUDGET, SECONDARY ROAD SYSTEM YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1962.

Mr. H. A. Fennel, Resident Engineer, from the Department of Highways presented to the Board the final budget for the year ending June 30, 1962, as to the secondary road system of Dinwiddie County showing the proposed improvements and months thereto, which budget was gone over with the Board by the Engineer and on motion duly made and carried was adopted as the final budget for the State Secondary Road System, Dinwiddie County, for the year ending June 30, 1962.

IN RE: STREET LIGHTS, ROUTE #460.

Mr. T. R. Graham and others having presented a petition requesting that a street light be installed on Route #460,

Motion was duly made and carried that Mr. M. G. Chandler and a member of the Virginia Electric & Power Company investigate as to the need of this light and report at the next meeting.

IN RE: STREET LIGHT - FORT LEE ROAD.

Mr. Alfred Haase and others having requested that two street lights be installed on Fort Lee Road,

Motion was duly made and carried that Mr. M. G. Chandler and a member of the Virginia Electric & Power Company investigate as to the need of these lights and report at the next meeting.

IN RE: CIVIL WAR CENTENNIAL COMMISSION.

The Civil War Centennial Commission having recommended that Mrs. Emily B. Zehmer and Mrs. Sallie E. H. Short be appointed to their commission,

Motion was duly made and carried that this appointment be approved.

IN RE: PLAT OF HARVEY YOUNG, LOTS 23, 24 AND 25 APPROVED.

Mr. Harvey Young having presented a plat of Lots #23, 24, and 25 and requested permission to divide these lots so as to take care of three dwellings and it appearing that the plat had been approved by the Department of Health,

Motion was duly made and carried that this request be granted and the plat to be recorded in the Clerk's Office.

IN RE: GRAVEL FOR AGRICULTURAL BUILDING DRIVES.

Upon request of Mr. B. F. Bedwell, permission is granted for obtaining crushed stone for the agriculture building drives.
