IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salaries and accounts against the General Fund of the County for the month of October, 1962, amounting to \$ be allowed and checks numbering 1 through , both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the General Revenue Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered that a salary of \$166.66 be paid to the Dog Warden, and that \$105.00 be paid to him as mileage for the month of October, and that claims amounting to \$ be paid out of the Dog Fund of the County for the month of October, and checks numbering D-1 through D- , both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the said Dog Fund of the County. Said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT.

F. E. Jones, Treasurer having submitted a written financial report same was ordered filed with the papers of the Board for the month of November, 1962.

IN RE: REPLACEMENT OF WATER TANK-DINWIDDIE FIRE TRUCK.

The water tank on the 1955 Ford Fire Truck used by Dinwiddie Volunteer Fire Company, being in such a condition from excess rust that repairs may not be possible,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Clerk secure bids and purchase from the lowest bidder a new water tank when necessary.

IN RE: BERNICE B. WHITMORE - J. B. VICK, PLATS.

A plat of 0.36 acres to be acquired by Bernice B. Whitmore and a plat of 3.095 acres subdivided for J. B. Vick having been presented for the approval of this Board and it appearing that neither of these plats have been approved by the Health Department or the Highway Department same are referred to these departments for investigation and report.

IN RE: EXTENSION OF RT. 9118, REQUEST FOR SECONDARY INCLUSION.

It appearing to the Board that the newly constructed extension of State Highway No. 9118 consisting of a length of road 305' located behind Dinwiddie High School, has been completed to State required specifications;

Motion was duly made and carried that the Highway Department include this road in its Secondary System. The County hereby guarantees a thirty foot right of way.

IN RE: SECONDARY ROAD SYSTEM FINAL BUDGET APPROVED.

Mr. H.A. Fennell, Resident Engineer, from the Department of Highways presented to the Board the final budget for the year ending June 30, 1963 as to the Secondary Road System of Dinwiddie County showing the proposed improvements and maintenance thereto which budget was gone over with the engineer by the Board and on motion duly made and carried was adopted as the final budget for the State Secondary Roads of Dinwiddie County for the year ending June 30, 1963.

IN RE: HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT - REQUEST TO WIDEN HEALTH CENTER ENTRANCE.

The West entrance to Dinwiddie County Health Center being too narrow to make a turn off the Southbound lane from U. S. Highway No. 1,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Highway Department be requested to widen this entrance as soon as practical.

IN RE: PUBLIC HEARING - ORDINANCE TO INCREASE DOG LICENSE.

The public hearing on the ordinance to increase dog license having been well attended by citizens opposing the proposed ordinance and it being the opinion of the Commonwealth's Attorney that special legislature would be required before this ordinance could be adopted by this Board,

Motion was duly made and carried that any action on this ordinance be tabled.

IN RE: DOG WARDEN - CONFINING DOGS, ETC.

Quite a long discussion was held concerning the appointment of two or four Dog Wardens for the County and also the confining of dogs in the County for a period of four to six weeks nothing of which was agreed upon -

Motion was finally made and carried that any action on the dog problem be tabled for further study.

IN RE: SECTION 15-244; 29-194 & 33-279.3, LETTER CONCERNING.

Mr. M. Watkins Booth, Commonwealth's Attorney as requested at the October meeting presented the members with letters containing the Code Sections concerning
15-244 Board to set with open doors
33-279.3 Automobile graveyards
29-194 County may prohibit dogs running at large as requested at the October meeting.

IN RE: ORDINANCE TO PARALLEL STATE D. D. LAW.

The Commonwealth's Attorney having suggested that the County ordinance concerning driving while under the influence of alcoholic beverages be amended to parallel the amended State Code,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Commonwealth's Attorney prepare the proper amendments and present same at the next meeting.

IN RE: REPORT OF PETERSBURG JAIL FARM-COMMITTEE.

The Committee named by the Chairman at the October meeting to contact the Mayor and Manager of the City of Petersburg concerning the care of county prisoners at the City Jail Farm now under construction reported that they had been assured of assistance from the City.

IN RE: STREET LIGHTS DINWIDDIE GARDENS & SOUTHERN PINES.

Mr. M. G. Chandler having recommended that 16 - 3000 lumen, mercury vapor, street lights be installed - 12 in Dinwiddie Gardens Subdivision and 4 in Southern Pines Subdivision,

Motion was duly made and carried that Virginia Electric and Power Company be requested to install these lights at the locations shown in their letter of September 21st.

IN RE: SANITARY DISTRICT HEARING.

November 20 & 27 were set as dates for a public hearing at Namozine Volunteer Fire house on the installation of water and sewerage in part of Namozine District.

IN RE: APPROPRIATION FOR LEAGUE OF VIRGINIA COUNTIES MEETING.

It appearing that the annual meeting of the League of Virginia Counties will be held November 11, 12, 13 in Richmond,

Motion was duly made and carried that \$100.00 be appropriated for expenses.

✓ IN RE: DORTCH ROAD - REQUEST EASEMENT FOR N. & W. PROPERTY.

The Highway Department having suggested that an easement be requested from the Norfolk & Western Railroad for a right of way across their property to build a road known as the Dortch Road,

Motion was duly made and carried that the clerk write the N. & W. R.R. and request the proper easement.

IN RE: SURVEY AND PLAT-WM. H. PEGRAM AND RUTH G. COLEMAN ROADS.

The Highway Department having suggested that surveys and plats be made of the proposed roads known as the WM.H.Pegram road and the Ruth G. Coleman road,

Motion was duly made and carried that the clerk write one of the petitioners from each road and inform them that a survey and plat must be presented before further action can be taken.

IN RE: RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO DIBREL CARLETON MAYES.

WHEREAS, Dibrel Carleton Mayes resigned as Commonwealth Attorney for Dinwiddie County to become Judge of the Fourth Judicial Circuit on September 18th, 1962, and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the members of this Board to record our appreciation for the service he has rendered the County as Commonwealth Attorney and as legal adviser for this Board and,

WHEREAS, the record of the county government is reflected by the diligent and conscientious work of Gus during his services from January 1st, 1962 until his resignation.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that we express to him our appreciation for a service well rendered and we regret this loss but wish him success in his tenure as Judge.
