On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered that a salary of \$166.66 be paid to the Dog Warden and that \$105.00 be paid to him as mileage for the month of March, 1963 and that claims amounting to \$155.14 be paid out of the Dog Fund of the County for the month of March, 1963, and checks numbering D-1 through D-9, both inclusive, be issued, therefor payable out of the Dog Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT.

F. E. Jones, Treasurer having submitted a written financial report, same was ordered filed with the papers of the Board for the month of March, 1963.

IN RE: \$50,000.00 LITERARY LOAN.

It appearing to the Board that the County will need the \$50,000.00 balance from the \$ 100,000.00 loan applied for from the State Literary Fund.

The Board feeling that some special recognition should be made regarding the distinguished service of Hon. John Garland Jefferson, Jr., as Judge of the Fourth Judicial Circuit of which Dinwiddie County is a part,

On motion duly made and carried Mrs. Chas. F. Hargrave and H. Barner Batte are appointed to serve with representatives from the City of Petersburg Bar Association and the Counties of Amelia, Nottoway, and Powhatan, to select a studio to make heavy oil photo portraits of Judge Jefferson to be hung in Circuit Courtroom of Dinwiddie County and any of the aforementioned counties and in the Courtroom of Hustings Court of Petersburg if the Petersburg Bar Association and the counties desire to join therein.

The said Mrs. Chas. F. Hargrave and H. Barner Batte are given the authority to make any or all decisions for this Board concerning the portrait and presentation.

IN RE: STREET LIGHTS WESTERN HILLS CIRCLE DRIVE AND WEST LANE.

A. Mitchell Smith with a VEPCO representative having investigated a request for the installation of street lights in Western Hill Subdivision on Circle Drive and West Lane and,

It appearing from their report that the needs can best be met by installing two street lights on Circle Drive and three street lights on West Lane,

Motion was duly made and carried that Virginia Electric and Power Company make the installations as shown in the report.

IN RE: PLAT OF HERMITAGE HILLS.

A plat of Hermitage Hills having been presented and it appearing that this plat has been approved by the Department of Health and also approved by the Department of Highways with the exception of a street not now paved or used by the public,

Motion was duly made and carried that the plat be approved provided the said mentioned street shall be marked "RESERVED FOR A STREET", and with the requirement that any building permit must have the prior approval of the Department of Health, and the Clerk is directed to record this plat when so requested.

IN RE: ORDINANCE, AUTO GRAVEYARD.

Watkins Booth the Commonwealth Attorney for Dinwiddie County having presented a proposed ordinance paralleling the State Ordinance concerning Automobile graveyards, and, the Board being of the opinion, with the concurrence of Mr. Booth, that nothing would be gained by the adoption of a County Ordinance,

Motion was duly made and carried that no action be taken for the adoption of the ordinance.

IN RE: BUILDING PERMITS - JAMES EMORY AND RICHARD MANN.

The Board having deferred action on request of James Emory for a building permit on Dupuy Road in connection with a proposed Auto Graveyard and the request of Richard Mann for a building permit in connection with a proposed auto graveyard on Rt. 142, and,

It appearing that the County Planning Commission has recommended that this Board not approve these permits as both locations are in residential sections of the County,
and

Motion duly made and carried, the Commissioner of Revenues is hereby directed not to issue these building permits.

IN RE: HUNTING IN COUNTY WITH RIFLES.

A number of complaints from residents of Dinwiddie County having been received by L. W. Coleman, Supervisor from Darvills District, concerning the use of Rifles larger than 22 calibre for hunting deer and other game in the County.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Commonwealth Attorney and the Game Warden are requested to consult the State

Game Commissioner and have the use of Rifles with a larger calibre than 22 for hunting in Dinwiddie County to be prohibited.

There is no allocation, or designation of any funds of this county for any purpose until there has been an appropriation for that purpose by the Board of Supervisors.

A hearing will be held by the Board of Supervisors on the budget for informative purposes at the courthouse on the 3rd day of May, 1963, at 2:00 P.M., at which time any citizens of this county shall have the right to attend and state his views. The budget is for informative and fiscal planning purposes and will not be approved, adopted, or ratified by the Board of Supervisors.

IN RE: TAX LEVY RATE FOR 1963

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Dinwiddie, Virginia, that there be, and is hereby, levied, for the year 1963, a tax of \$3.00 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on all taxable real estate located in this County, and that there be, and is hereby, levied, for the year 1963, a tax of \$3.00 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on all taxable tangible personal property located in this County on January 1, 1963, the respective levies hereby ordered being also applicable to the real estate and tangible personal property of public service corporations, based upon the assessment thereof fixed by the State Corporation Commission and duly certified.
