IN RE: READING OF MINUTES.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salaries and accounts against the General Revenue Fund of the County for the month of May, 1963, amounting to \$9,214.83 be allowed and checks numbering 1 through 89, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the General Revenue and fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered that a salary of \$166.66 be paid to the Dog Warden and that \$105.00 be paid to him as mileage for the month of May, 1963 and that claims amounting to \$74.64 be paid out of the Dog Fund of the County for the month of May, 1963, and checks numbering D-1 through D-6, both inclusive, be issued, therefor payable out of the Dog Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

It appearing to the Board that there will be some hardship placed upon the Citizens of Dinwiddie County in complying with the ordinance concerning the vaccination of dogs for rabies,

Upon motion duly made and carried the Treasurer is directed to allow a credit of 50¢ on each male, unsexed and female dog license said credit not to exceed \$5.00 on each 20 dog kennel license and \$10.00 on each 50 dog kennel license.

This credit shall not be allowed after June 30th, 1964 without further approval of this Board.

IN RE: ADDITION TO SCHOOLS, RESOLUTION RESCINDED.

Zehmer, duly seconded and unaimously carried, it was resolved that the resolution adopted on May 3, 1963 directing the school board to proceed with the plan for the proposed additions of six rooms at Southside Elementary and four rooms at McKenney Elementary Schools be rescinded.
