IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salaries and accounts against the General Revenue Fund of the County for the month of August, 1963 amounting to \$15,121.45 be allowed and checks numbering 1 through 94, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the General Revenue and fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered that a salary of \$166.66 be paid to the Dog Warden and that \$105.00 be paid to him as mileage for the month of August, 1963 and that claims amounting to \$163.64 be paid out of the Dog Fund of the County for the month of August, 1963, and checks numbering D-1 through D-8, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the Dog Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT.

F. E. Jones, Treasurer having submitted a written financial report, same was ordered filed with the papers of the Board for the month of September, 1963.

IN RE: JUDGE JEFFERSON'S PORTRAIT, PROGRAM COMMITTEE.

The clerk having reported to the Board that the portraits of Judge J. G. Jefferson, Jr., had been completed and delivered to Nottoway, Powhatan, the City of Petersburg and Dinwiddie County at a cost of \$128.89 each from Fosters Studio,

Motion was duly made and carried that H. B. Batte, B. Hunter Barrow and M. Watkins Booth act as a committee to plan a proper program for presentation of Judge Jefferson's portrait at the September term of the Circuit Court of this county.

IN RE: REPAIRS TO PARKING LOT BACK OF COURTHOUSE.

Mr. H. A. Fennell, resident engineer having submitted and estimate in the amount of \$260.00 for grading, adding base and surface treating the area behind the courthouse.

Motion was duly made and carried that the State Highway Department complete this project as soon as possible and bill the County for same.

IN RE: UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA HOSPITAL - CONTRACT FOR INDIGENT PERSONS.

A new contract effective July 1, 1963 to July 1, 1964, with the University of Virginia Hospital, for treatment of indigent persons at the rate of \$27.32 per patient day, having been presented.

Motion duly made and carried that the contract be and hereby is approved by the Board and the Chairman is directed to execute same.

IN RE: ANNEXATION BY PETERSBURG ( COUNTY COMMITTEE).

The Board having met with the Mayor, City Manager, and Engineer of Petersburg to discuss the city's plans to annex a part of Dinwiddie County, at which meeting it was tentatively agreed that the county and city would each appoint two representatives to work with Petersburg official in making a study of the annexation,

Motion was duly made and carried appointing L. W. Coleman, R.F.D., McKenney, Virginia and L. L. Meredith, R.F.D. Dinwiddie, Virginia to represent Dinwiddie County.

IN RE: RELEASE OF PRINTS OF DINWIDDIE COUNTY MAPS BY STATE OFFICE.

Mr. Ernest C. Cury, Jr., Supervisor of mapping having requested permission to release prints of Dinwiddie County maps on file in his office when requested to persons that request these maps,

Motion was duly made and carried that prints of Dinwiddie County maps be released upon authorization of the Commissioner of Revenue of this county.

IN RE: ORDINANCE REGULATING "AUTOMOBILE GRAVEYARDS" DEFINED: LIMITATIONS ON ESTABLISHMENT AND USE: WHEN FENCES AND HEDGES REQUIRED: MISDEMEANOR: EACH DAY'S SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION A SEPARATE OFFENSE. - FINAL ADOPTION

IN RE: ORDINANCE PLACING LICENSE ON TRAILER CAMPS ETC.

The following ordinance having been presented by the Commonwealth's Attorney and discussed at length,

Motion was duly made and carried that same be adopted and the Clerk is directed to publish proper notice of a public hearing concerning this ordinance on October 4th at 2:00 P.M:

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ASSESSMENT BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DINWIDDIE COUNTY OF COUNTY LICENSE TAXES UPON THE OPERATION OF TRAILER CAMPS AND TRAILER PARKS, AND THE PARKING OF TRAILERS, AND THE PUNISHMENT FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County, as follows:

1. Every person, firm or corporation who shall operate or conduct any trailer camp, or trailer park, as hereinafter defined, in the County of Dinwiddie, Virginia, shall obtain a county license therefor.

2. For the purpose of this ordinance, a "trailer" shall mean any vehicle used, or intended for use, as a conveyance upon highways, do designed and so constructed as to permit occupancy thereof as a temporary or permanent dwelling or sleeping place for one or more persons. A "trailer park" or "trailer camp" shall mean any site, lot, field, or tract of land upon which is located one or more trailers, or is held out for the location of any trailer, and shall include any building, structure, tent, vehicle or enclosure used, or intended for use as a part of the equipment for such part. A "trailer lot" shall mean a unit of land used, or intended to be used, by one trailer.

3. On and after the effective date of this ordinance it shall be unlawful within the limits of Dinwiddie County, for any person to park any trailer on any street, alley, highway or other public place in said county, except in a trailer park for which the operator thereof has obtained a license in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, except, however, that one trailer may be parked or stored in an improved, enclosed garage or accessory building, or on any lot or plot of land, provided, however, that no living quarters shall be maintained, or any business practiced while such trailer is so parked or stored.

4. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed as exempting any trailer part or trailer camp operator from the payment of any license or tax imposed by existing law.

5. There is hereby imposed an annual license tax on the operator or owner of a trailer park or trailer camp, located in the County of Dinwiddie, of \$50.00 per trailer lot used, ~~or intended to be used as such~~. Application for such license shall be made to the Commissioner of the Revenue of said County for such license, and there shall be attached by the applicant to such application a plat or sketch, upon which shall be designated the location of said trailer park or trailer camp, the name of the owner or operator thereof, and the actual or approximate layout and number of the trailer lots used, or intended to be used, as such.

6. Any license applied for and issued under the provisions of this Ordinance may be applied for and issued on a quarterly basis, according to the number of lots in use at the beginning of the quarter.

7. A single trailer owned and occupied by the owner of the land upon which it is situated, or owned and occupied by a

related to such owner by blood or marriage, is hereby excepted from the provisions of this ordinance.

8. Any provision of this Ordinance found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be ineffective, shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, and such remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

9. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than fifty (\$50.00) dollars, nor more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for each offense; and each consecutive day of operation of a trailer camp or trailer park by any owner or operator thereof who has not obtained the license provided for herein, shall constitute a separate offense.

10. On and after the effective date of this ordinance it shall be the duty of any and all persons or corporation to obtain a permit before placing a trailer upon any parcel or tract of land in the County of Dinwiddie which permit shall be issued by the Commissioner of Revenue of said County, without cost to the applicant.

11. A fee of seventy-five cents (75¢) shall be paid to F. E. Jones, Treasurer for each annual license issued and a fee of fifty cents (50¢) shall be paid to said Treasurer for each quarterly license issued, said fees to be paid into the general fund of the County by said Treasurer.

12. On and after the effective date of this ordinance all trailers in the County of Dinwiddie, Virginia, and those that are moved into the County after the effective date of this ordinance shall have running water in each trailer and each trailer shall be connected to a sanitary sewer approved by the Sanitation Officer of the County.

13. This ordinance shall become and be in full force and effect on January 1, 1964, and thereafter.

IN RE: DINWIDDIE COUNTY HIGHWAY NEEDS - DISCUSSED.

Mr. H. A. Fennell, resident engineer discussed Dinwiddie County Highway needs with the Board as outlined by the Department of Highways.

IN RE: UNIFORM: SHERIFF A. HILL BURTON.

Sheriff A. Hill Burton having suggested that he be furnished with a uniform to wear while on duty.

Motion was duly made and carried that he select a suitable uniform and present an invoice for same to the County.

It was further moved that beginning January 1st, 1964 he be allowed \$100.00 per year clothing allowance.

IN RE: FIXTURES FOR COURTHOUSE BASEMENT STORAGE ROOM.

The clerk having requested permission to purchase docket files and roller shelves from the City of Chesapeake to be used in the basement storage room,

Motion was duly made and carried that he be permitted to purchase this equipment in an amount not exceeding \$500.00.
