IN RE: ALLOWANCE AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered that a salary of \$166.66 be paid to the Dog Warden and that \$105.00 be paid to him as mileage for the month of September, 1963 and that claims amounting to \$124.19 be paid out of the Dog Fund of the County for the month of September, 1963, and checks numbering D-1 through D-9, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the Dog Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT.

F. E. Jones, Treasurer having submitted a written financial report, same was ordered filed with the papers of the Board for the month of October, 1963.

IN RE: BIDS ON ADDITIONS TO SCHOOLS.

Mr. Hodge having informed the Board that bids on the additions for Southside Elementary and McKenney Elementary Schools would be opened at the Courthouse on October 15, 1963 at 2:30 P.M.

And it appearing that the Supervisors will not be able to attend this meeting.

Upon motion duly made and carried the School Board is authorized to accept or reject any or all bids for the County.

IN RE: BRICKWOOD MANOR SUBDIVISION, FAIRWAY ROAD, DRIVER ROAD, GREENWAY ROAD AND WEDGEWOOD ROAD.

It appearing to the Board that plat of this street known as Fairway Road duly recorded in Plat Book 5, page 19 on June 10, 1963 is 50' in width and beginning at a point on Route 460, 0.04 mile west of Route 1314 and running in a northerly direction a distance of 0.36 mile to cul-de-sac and dead end.

It further appearing to the Board from plat of this street known as Driver Road duly recorded in Plat Book 5 Page 19 on June 10, 1963 is 50 feet in width and beginning at a point on Fairway Road 0.15 mile north of Route 460 running in a westerly direction a distance of 0.17 mile to Greenway Road.

It further appearing to the Board from plat of this street known as Greenway Road duly recorded in Plat Book 5 Page 19 dated June 10, 1963, is 50 feet in width beginning at the intersection of Driver Road 0.17 mile west of Fairway Road running in a northerly direction a distance of 0.10 mile to Wedgewood Road.

It further appearing to the Board from plat of this street known as Wedgewood Road duly recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 19, dated June 10, 1963 is 50 feet in width and beginning at a point on Fairway Road 0.24 mile north of Route 460 running in a westerly direction 0.20 mile to Greenway Road.

It further appearing to the Board that these streets have been constructed and surfaced in accordance with the State Highway Specifications and the County Ordinance, motion was duly made and carried that the State Highway Department be requested to add these streets to the State Secondary System of Dinwiddie County with the provisions that the subdivider furnish the Department with the required bond and maintenance fee.

IN RE: PRELIMINARY PLAT OF INDIAN LAKES.

A preliminary plat of Indian Lakes was presented by James A. Musgrove and discussed.

IN RE: SOUTHERN PINES SUBDIVISION.

It appearing to the Board that a street extension to Pinecroft Road in Southern Pines Subdivision and known as Pinecroft Road Extended, beginning at the intersection of Rte. 1328 and 1329, 0.20 mile West of Rte. 600 running in a westerly direction a distance of 0.09 mile, to dead end with cul-de-sac. It further appearing to the Board that it has been constructed and surfaced in accordance with the State Highway Specifications and County Ordinance.

Said Plat being recorded in Plat Book 5 Page 16 on April 5, 1963 and owners consent and dedication being recorded in Deed Book 113 Page 203, dated December 29, 1961.

Motion was made and duly carried that the State Highway Department be requested to add the street to the State Secondary System in Dinwiddie County.

IN RE: PLAT OF HERITAGE HILL SUBDIVISION: APPROVE.

A plat of Heritage Hill having been considered by the Board, was approved, generally with the direction that any building permit issued in connection therewith must have the prior approval of the County Department of Health.

It was further directed that the Clerk record this plat when so requested.

IN RE: REQUEST TO WIDEN RT. 460.

The Board being of the opinion that it would be to the best interest of the public to widen Rt. 460 from Jack, Virginia to it's intersection with U.S. #1

Upon motion duly made and carried the Department of Highways is requested to consider this proposal.

IN RE: PROPOSED ROAD FROM 460 TO INT. OF 85 AND U. S. 1.

It appearing to the Board that it would be to the best interest of the public if a road connecting Rt. 460 with Rt. 85 at its intersection with U.S. 1 was constructed.

Upon motion duly made and carried the Department of Highways is requested to consider the construction of the above mentioned road.

IN RE: REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO RT. 85 FROM 613.

It being brought to the attention of the Board that there is a possibility that the Highway Department would consider the construction of an access to Rt. 85 from Rt. 613,

Upon motion duly made and carried the Department of Highways is requested to add this access if it can be done in addition to the presently planned interchange at the intersection of Rt. 1 and Rt. 85,

IN RE: REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO RT. 85 FROM RT. 619.

Mr. Floyd Abernathy having appeared before the Board and requested that an access to Rt. 85 from Rt. 619 be constructed, and,

It appearing to the Board that an access has been planned from Rt. 703 to Rt. 85, which is about one mile north of 619.

Upon motion duly made and carried the Department of Highways is requested to consider this access provided it in no way changes the present plan for Rt. 703 access.

IN RE: ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE - TREASURER OFFICE - STATIONERY & EQUIPMENT.

It appearing to the Board that the payment of June expense voucher for office equipment has overdrawn the equipment account \$22.70 and that the August expense voucher for tax tickets has overdrawn the stationery account \$206.89,

Motion/duly made and carried that additional allowances be made to take care of this deficit.

IN RE: FEE, FOR DUPLICATE VACCINE DOG TAG.

At the suggestion of Dr. W. R. Ferguson, Motion was duly made and carried that a fee of 25¢ shall be charged for a duplicate vaccine certificate.

IN RE: AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ASSESSMENT BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DINWIDDIE COUNTY OF COUNTY LICENSE TAXES UPON THE OPERATION OF TRAILER CAMPS AND TRAILER PARKS, AND THE PARKING OF TRAILERS, AND THE PUNISHMENT FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE SAME.

This ordinance having been properly advertised and set for a hearing on this date,

Upon motion duly made and carried, was adopted, effective 1/1/64.
