IN RE: ORDINANCE APPROVING THE VACATION OF THE FOLLOWING REFERRED TO MAPS OF PARKVIEW SUBDIVISION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DINWIDDIE COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

It having been called to the attention of the Board of Supervisors that Alfred Haase, Sr., Trustee for Alfred Haase, Jr., and Alfred Haase, individually, by deed dated September 18, 1956 and recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Dinwiddie County, Virginia on September 27, 1956, in D.B. 63, at page 359, vacated that certain map of Parkview Subdivision, and the streets thereon, made by F.D.P. Bruner, Surveyor dated November, 1938 and recorded in Deed Book 62, at page 435 and said deed also vacated the streets and alleys shown on that certain Map showing Section One of Parkview Subdivision" dated May, 1941 and made by J. W. Pugh, Surveyor, of record in Deed Book 63 at page 359, however Alfred Haase, Sr., Trustee for Alfred Haase, Jr., and Alfred Haase, individually, failed to obtain the approval of this Board to vacate said Maps and streets and it appearing to this Board that there is no sound reason why it should not approve the vacation of the aforesaid Map, made by F.D.P. Bruner, Surveyor, dated November, 1938, and the streets and alleys shown on said Map, and it further appearing to this Board that there is no good reason why this Board should not approved the vacating of the streets and alleys shown on the Map dated May, 1941, made by J.W.Pugh, surveyor, on motion duly made and carried, this Board hereby approves the vacating of the aforesaid Map made by F.D.P. Bruner, Surveyor and the vacating of the streets and alleys shown on the aforesaid Maps, made by the Messrs. Bruner and Pugh.
