IN RE: SCHOOL BOARD REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO OPTION SITE AND
CONTRACT ARCHETECTS.

Mr. George B. Hodge, Superintendent of Schools presented
a copy of the following resolution: adopted March 11, 1964 at 1:00 P.M.

"BE IT RESOLVED that the School Board of Dinwiddie hereby
request the Board of Supervisors of said County to authorize the
School Board to take an option or options for the purchase of a
site for the new consolidate High School, and to secure the services
of an architect or architects to prepare the plans and specifications
for said consolidated High School and,

It appearing to the Supervisors that a referendum was
held on March 10th, 1964 on the question; shall the county contract
a debt in the amount of ~~\$1,500.00~~ for the purpose of erecting
a consolidated high school and that the vote was 1812 for and

Board is proper,

Motion was duly made and unanimously carried that the
requests be granted, however no action shall be taken thereunder
by said School Board until the election has been certified by the
Commissioners of Elections and approved by the Circuit Court of
Dinwiddie County, Virginia.

IN RE: OFFICE SPACE - DR. RICHARD R. BUTTERWORTH.

Dr. Richard R. Butterworth having appeared before the
Board and requested an extension on the use of the dental facilities
of the County Health Department as there has been some delay in
the construction of his new office.

Upon motion duly made and carried the Dr. Butterworth
be given an extension to May 15th, 1964.

IN RE: PRECINCT POLLING PLACES - CONSOLIDATION AND RELOCATION:

It appearing to the Board that there are fifteen polling
places in the County some of which can be consolidated and/or
relocated to be more convient to the public.

Motion was duly made and carried that the County Board
of Elections make a study of the polling places in the county and
also give some consideration as to the per diem pay for judges and
clerk's.

IN RE: HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUDGET 1964-65.

A budget for the Department of Health was presented
amounting to \$7,783.63 which was ordered filed with the Clerk
for consideration with the other budget requests.

IN RE: FIRE SIREN. FORD VOL. FIRE DEPT.

Prices having been requested for a siren for Ford Volunteer
Fire Department and it appearing that there is a wide variation in
the price of sirens due to phase of current available.

Motion was duly made and carried that the Ford Department
select the best siren for the price and have same installed with
the county paying 2/3 of the cost.

IN RE: SCHOOL BUDGET 1964-65.

The Superintendent of Schools presented the school budget
which was discussed and filed for consideration with the other budget
requests.

IN RE: . CLERK'S REPORT - TYPEWRITER, DEED BOOKS, REPAIRS.

H. B. Batte, Clerk reported that a Remington typewriter #230304008 was purchased fro \$211.50. The old typewriter was repaired for \$28.00 and placed in the Registrar office. The typewriter in the Commonwealth's Office was repaired for \$28.00.

Bids were received on Deed Books for Clerk's Office and purchased for the low bid price of \$22.50 each against \$31.00. The Peeler Bindery Company 621 West 12th St. Bonham, Texas submitted the lowest price for recovering and repairing the books in the Clerk's Office \$570.00 - Sowers \$682.00 - Dobbs \$775.00

RE: REFERENDUM AS TO BOND ISSUE TO CONSOLIDATE HIGH SCHOOLS

COUNTY OF DINWIDDIE, TO-WIT:

An abstract of votes cast in the special election held in Dinwiddie County, Virginia, on the 10th day of March, 1964, to take the sense of the qualified voters of Dinwiddie County whether said County shall issue general obligation bonds of said County in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars for various school purposes, the question presented at said election being as follows:

Question: Shall the County of Dinwiddie, Virginia contract a debt in the amount of \$1,500,000.00 for the purposes of erecting a consolidated high school, additions to school buildings, furnishing and equipping new and existing school buildings, including the purchase of sites for school buildings, or additions to school buildings, and erecting other improvements to the school system in Dinwiddie County, Virginia and borrow such amount by issuing general obligation bonds of the County of Dinwiddie in the maximum amount of \$1,500,000.00 to finance said projects pursuant to Chapter 19.1, Article 3, Title 15 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended?
