IN RE:        READING OF MINUTES.

The minutes of the previous meeting was approved without being read.

IN RE:        ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salaries and accounts against the General Fund of the County for the month of October, 1964 amounting to \$7,695.41 be allowed and checks numbering 425 to 542, both inclusive, be issued, therefor payable out of the General Fund of the County, said claims have been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE:        ALLOWANCE AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salary of \$250.00 be paid to the Dog Warden and that \$105.00 be paid to him as mileage for the month of October, 1964 and that claims amounting to \$72.73 be allowed and checks numbering D-31 to D-37 both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the Dog Fund of the County, said claims have been investigated by the Dog Warden and approved for payment by the Board.

IN RE:        TREASURER'S REPORT.

F. E. Jones, Treasurer, having submitted a written financial report, same was ordered filed with the papers of the Board for the month of November, 1964.

IN RE:        REPORT OF DR. W. R. FERGUSON - CONTRACEPTIVE PROGRAM

Dr. Ferguson reported on the contraceptive program of the Health Department after which it was suggested that he work closely with the County Welfare Department on this program.

Dr. Ferguson also discussed the practice of some counties to have the dog wardens vaccinate dogs for rabies. The Commonwealths Attorney was requested to check the laws concerning this.

IN RE:        MICROFILM EQUIPMENT FOR CLERK'S OFFICE.

Upon request of H. B. Batte, Clerk,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Clerk be allowed to purchase microfilm equipment for his office subject to the approval of the State Compensation Board not to exceed \$3,000.00.

IN RE:        PURCHASE OF CHAIRS, DESK AND FILE.

Motion was duly made and carried that the Clerk purchase from the Industrial Department of the State Penitentiary;

IN RE:        STREET LIGHTS - WARRENTON HEIGHTS.

A petition signed by residents of Warrenton Heights requesting the installation of street lights in their area having been received,

Motion was duly made and carried that A. Mitchell Smith and a representative of Vepco investigate this and report at the next meeting.

IN RE:        COL. ERNEST JONES ROAD - FILED FOR ROAD VIEWERS.

Col. Ernest Jones, Retired having requested the extension of a road 200' from John Brocks Land to the front of his house,

Motion was duly made and carried that the request be filed for consideration by the Road Viewers in April 1965.

IN RE: RT. 95 - STUDY OF PROPOSED LOCATION IN DINWIDDIE.

It appearing to the Board that 2 proposals have been made for the location of Rt. 95 near Carson, Virginia,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Board members study the proposals and report at the December meeting.

IN RE: REFUND OF CASH BOND TO BOGESE & MIZERA CONSTRUCTION CO.

Bogese & Mizera Construction Co., having appeared before the Board and stated that the streets in his "Ramblewood Subdivision" had been completed to State Specifications under the conditions of a \$5,000.00 and requested a refund of this bond and,

The Resident Engineer having substantiated this statement and suggested that Bogese & Mizera Construction Co., execute a Corporate Bond in the amount of \$1,000.00 under the condition that the said streets be kept in repair until taken in the secondary system by the State Highway Department,

Motion was duly made and carried that upon the execution of the above bond the Clerk is directed to pay to Bogese & Mizera Construction Co., \$5,000.00 with the accrued interest.

IN RE: REFUND OF CASH BOND TO JAMES W. MUSGROVE.

James W. Musgrove having appeared before the Board and stated that the lots in Indian Lakes Subdivision were to be acquired by the Highway Department for Route 95 right of way and requested that the \$1,200.00 cash bond posted in connection with the Subdivision Streets be refunded, and,

The Resident Engineer having substantiated Mr. Musgrove statement,

Motion was duly made and carried that the cash bond of \$1,200.00 plus accrued interest be paid Mr. Musgrove.

IN RE: TIRES NAMOZINE VOL. FIRE CO. - JEEP.

Permission was given the Namozine Vol. Fire Co. to purchase two (2) tires for their jeep.

IN RE: AGRICULTURAL BUILDING PARKING AREA & ROAD-ESTIMATE TO HARDSURFACE.

The Highway Department was requested to submit an estimate of the cost for hardsurfacing the entrance and parking area at the Agricultural Building.

IN RE: LIVESTOCK CLAIM - H. H. WILKERSON.

A claim for \$22.00 was filed by H. H. Wilkerson for a lamb killed by Joe Lewis' dog. After some discussion action was deferred until the December Meeting.

IN RE: DOG WARDEN - MILEAGE ALLOWANCE.

Effective January 1, 1965 A. W. Chappell County Dog Warden shall be allowed an increase of \$105.00 per month in lieu of any mileage allowance for his services as dog warden.

IN RE: ROAD ACROSS APPOMATTOX WATER AUTHORITY DAM REQUESTED.

It appearing to the Board that the Appomattox Water Authority plans the construction of a dam across the Appomattox River, and,

It further appearing that it has been proposed by the Chesterfield Board of Supervisors that a road connecting Rt. 601 in Dinwiddie County with Rt 36 in Chesterfield County be constructed across this dam, and,

Upon motion duly made and carried this Board requests that the Highway Department give consideration to this proposal and allocate funds for that purpose if possible.

IN RE: ROBERT RITCHIE APPOINTED MEMBER APPOMATTOX RIVER WATER AUTHORITY.

It appearing to the Board the term of the present members of the Appomattox River Water Authority will expire on November 21, 1964,

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Board doth appoint Robert Ritchie as a member of the Appomattox River Water Authority for a period of four (4) years beginning November, 21, 1964.

IN RE: ANNEXATION - CITY OF PETERSBURG.

The Board of Supervisors having met in Executive Session in the Clerk's Office and discussed the proposal of the City of Petersburg to annex approximately 3.5 sq. miles of Dinwiddie County and later driven around a portion of the property to be annexed, and,

Several of the members being of the opinion that the citizens of Dinwiddie County desire that any annexation of county property be protested in the Courts.

Motion was duly made and carried with L. L. Meredith voting in the negative that the Clerk write the Council of the City of Petersburg of their intention.

IN RE: ROAD VIEWERS REPORT - WINGFIELD ROAD.

The road viewers having recommended that a road known as the Wingfield Road, beginning at a point on Route 665, 0.26 mile west of the east intersection of Route 633 running in a northerly direction 0.34 mile to dead end, be taken into the Secondary System when the necessary 40 feet right of way is secured and duly recorded in accordance with the policy of the Virginia Department of Highways, and

Whereas, it now appears to the Board that the right of way has been duly secured and recorded in Deed Book 121 Page 42 with plat dated September 4, 1964, recorded in Plat Book 3 Page 20,

Motion was duly made and carried that this road be added to the Secondary System of Dinwiddie County.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
