IN RE: READING OF MINUTES.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salaries and accounts against the General Fund of the County for the month of October, 1966 amounting to \$6,523.59 be allowed and check numbering 66-1202 thru 66-1246, both inclusive, be issued, therefor payable out of the General Fund of the County, said claims have been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARY AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salary of \$355.00 be paid to the Dog Warden for the month of October, 1966 and that claims and accounts amounting to \$35.00 be allowed and check numbering D-66-63 thru D-66-66 both inclusive, be issued, therefor payable out of the Dog Fund of the County, said claims have been investigated by the Dog Warden and approved for payment by the Board.

IN RE: PURCHASE OF AUTOMOBILES FOR SHERIFFS DEPARTMENT.

The Sheriff having been authorized October 5th, 1966 to advertise for bids for purchase of 5 new automobiles presented the following bids:

Mr. Meredith moved that this Board accept Ted Curry's low bid of \$11,374.25 without air conditioning. There was no second. Mr. Hauser moved that this Board accept Ted Curry's bid of \$12,980.50 with air conditioning. Mr. Winn seconded. Motion carried 3-1 (Mr. Hauser, Mr. Winn, Mr. Smith voted "yes", Mr. Meredith voted "no").

IN RE: HUNTING IN CONGESTED AREAS.

There was a discussion concerning the dangers of hunting in the congested areas of Dinwiddie County.

Mr. Winn moved that the Commonwealth Attorney prepare an ordinance to prevent hunting north of the N. & W. Belt Line R.R. from the Prince George County Line to the Rohoic District line (Rt. 632) Mr. Hauser seconded. Motion carried.

IN RE: CHILDRENS HOME SOCIETY - REQUEST FOR DONATION.

There was read a letter from the Children's Home Society of Virginia requesting a contribution for the continuance of the society's work. No action was taken.

IN RE: JOHN TYLER COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

There was read a letter from John Tyler Community College requesting that Dinwiddie County reconfirm its original pledge to support the John Tyler Community College. It was pointed out that 1/2 of the original \$15,000.00 pledge had been paid.

Mr. Meredith moved that the County of Dinwiddie reconfirm its pledge in support of John Tyler Community College. Mr. Winn seconded. Motion was unanimously carried.
