IN RE: MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved without being read.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES FROM THE GENERAL FUND.

On motion made and carried, it is ordered by the Board of Supervisors that the accounts against the General Fund of the County for the month of April 1968 amounting to \$8,058.54 be allowed and checks numbering 68-341 through 68-388, both inclusive be issued therefore payable out of the General Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARY AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salary of \$375.00 be paid to the Dog Warden for the Month of April 1968 and claims amounting to \$10.50 be paid and checks numbering D-68-27 through D-68-31 be issued, therefore payable out of the Dog Fund of the County.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT.

F. E. Jones, Treasurer, having submitted a written financial report same was ordered filed with papers of the Board for the month of April 1968.

IN RE: LANDFILL SURVEY

The Bureau of Solid Waste and Vector Control presented a Solid Waste Plan for Dinwiddie County as requested. Copies of the plan were distributed to members of the Board for future study.

IN RE: FOOD STAMP PROGRAM - APPROVED

There was received from the Welfare Department a request to be granted permission to enact a Food Stamp Program for this County. The program was explained to the members of the Board by the Welfare Superintendent, Chairman of the Welfare Board and a representative from the Department of Welfare & Institutions.

After discussion, Mr. Winn moved the Welfare Department be authorized to submit an application to participate in the Food Stamp Program. Mr. Tunstall seconded. Motion was carried unanimously.

IN RE: HOME BUILDER'S ASSOCIATION - RECOMMEND ZONING CHANGES.

Representatives of the Home Builder's Association of Southside Virginia appeared before the Board and recommended that certain portions of the zoning ordinance pertaining to setback requirements and side yard requirements be reviewed and changed. The Association charged that the present requirements in R-1 areas were too strict and not in harmony with adjoining areas.

After discussion Mr. Hargrave moved this be referred to the Planning Commission and the Executive Secretary prepare a comparison of the adjacent counties' zoning ordinances and the proposed changes. Mr. Watkins seconded. Motion was carried.

IN RE: STATEMENT OF VALUES

The annual statement of values of buildings to be used for insurance purposes was reviewed and approved as follows:
