

VIRGINIA: AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DINWIDDIE COUNTY HELD AT THE AGRICULTURAL BUILDING OF SAID COUNTY ON THE 4TH DAY OF NOVEMBER 1970 AT 2:45 P.M.

A. H. BURTON SHERIFF

The meeting of the Dinwiddie County Board of Supervisors was called to order at 2:45 P.M.. The start of the meeting was delayed from 2:00 P.M. to 2:45 P.M. so that the members of the Board could attend the funeral of the Rev. J. R. MacAllister.

IN RE: MINUTES

Upon motion duly made and carried the minutes of the previous meeting were approved without being read.

IN RE: CLAIMS - PAYMENT

Upon motion duly made and carried it is ordered by the Board that the accounts against the following funds for the month of October 1970 be issued payable out of the respective accounts. General Fund - Checks numbering 70-1057 through 70-1101 amounting to \$9,952.04 Dog Fund - Checks numbering D-70-71 through D-70-75 amounting to \$647.05.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT

F. E. Jones, Treasurer presented his report for the month of October 1970. Upon examination, motion was made and carried approving said report and endorsing all transfers thereof.

As requested at the last meeting, the Executive Secretary asked Mr. Jones if money was available to purchase a fire truck for the Namozine Fire Department. Mr. Jones stated, "Yes."

The Executive Secretary reported that Mr. Raymond Crouch of the Department of Purchases & Supply stated that the chassis required for the Namozine Fire truck was not available now, nor would any be available next year.

The Chairman instructed the Executive Secretary to advise Colonial Ford and the John Bean Co. of the acceptance of their bid.

IN RE: SUPERINTENDENT SCHOOL BOARD - REQUEST NEW VEHICLE

Mr. T. W. Newsom, Superintendent of Schools, appeared before the Board and requested that he be provided with another car as the one he has is inoperable.

Upon motion of Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mr. Winn and unanimously carried the Executive Secretary was instructed to provide another car for Mr. Newsom.

IN RE: WELFARE DEPARTMENT - APPLICATIONS FOR ASSISTANCE APPROVED

Mrs. Jackie Williams appearing for the Welfare Department presented 2 applications for assistance. The applications of Mrs. Nannie Hill and Mrs. Eunice Hill were unanimously approved.

IN RE: HOSPITAL CONTRACT - GREENSVILLE HOSPITAL

A contract with Greenville Hospital was presented.

Upon motion of Mr. Winn, seconded by Mr. Tunstall and unanimously carried, with the Chairman voting "aye" the contract in the amount of \$38.29 per day was approved for the year 1970-71.

IN RE: BUILDING INSPECTOR

The Building Inspector presented his report for the month of October 1970.

IN RE: DOG WARDEN

Mr. A. W. Chappell presented his monthly report and two claims. Mr. W. H. Driggs requested payment for 11 rabbits and 9 chickens and Mr. Preston Ampy 1 pig.

Upon motion of Mr. Watkins, seconded by Mr. Winn, the Board unanimously granted Mr. Driggs \$11.00 for his rabbits and \$9.00 for his chickens. Mr. Preston Ampy was given \$10.00 for his pig.

IN RE: HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Mr. R. V. Lancaster, III, appeared for the Highway Department. Mr. Winn requested Mr. Lancaster to check out the railroad crossings on Route 650 and Route 656 in the DeWitt area because he had received numerous complaints as to their condition.

IN RE: PLAT - M. G. MAITLAND - APPROVED

The Executive Secretary explained to the Board that this was the 1st plat to his knowledge that had been presented for approval with the 100 foot frontage at the set back line and not at the front line of the lot. The 100 foot at the setback line was in accordance to the ordinance and the plat seemed to be in order.

Upon motion of Mr. Winn, seconded by Mr. Hargrave, the Board unanimously approved the plat and authorized the Chairman to sign same, subject to the Highway Department signing the plat.

IN RE: REPORT OF TAXES ASSESSED BY THE COMMISSIONER

Mr. R. W. Bridgman, Commissioner of the Revenue presented a report of the taxes assessed by the Commissioner of the Revenue's Office.

IN RE: JAIL PERSONNEL

Mr. A. Hill Burton, Sheriff, presented a request for 6 jailers at \$5,200.00 per year, 1 food planner at \$4,200.00 per year, 1 part-time food planner at \$2,100.00 per year, 1 full-time secretary at \$4,200.00 per year and 4 dispatchers at \$4,000.00 per year.

After a lengthy discussion Mr. Hargrave made the following motion. That the sheriff be provided with 1 additional jailer (total of 4), 1 dispatcher, 1 part-time dispatcher-jailer, 1 secretary, 1 food planner and 1 part time food planner and that an intercom system be installed to whatever degree is needed so that the above personnel may efficiently discharge their duties. This motion was seconded by Mr. Winn and unanimously carried by the Board.

IN RE: JAIL TELEPHONES

Upon motion of Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mr. Tunstall, the Board un-animously authorized the following telephone system to be installed in the new jail.
