

VIRGINIA: AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DINWIDDIE COUNTY HELD AT THE AGRICULTURAL BUILDING OF SAID COUNTY ON THE 7TH DAY OF APRIL 1971 AT 2:00 P.M.

IN RE: MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

IN RE: PAYMENT OF SALARIES & CLAIMS

Upon motion duly made and carried it is ordered by the Board that the accounts against the following funds for the month of March 1971 be issued payable out of the respective accounts. General Fund - Checks numbering 71-312 through 71-365 amounting to \$38,613.09. Dog Fund - Checks numbering D-71-20 through D-71-28 amounting to \$678.27.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT

F. E. Jones, Treasurer, presented his report for the month of March 1971. Upon examination, motion was made and carried approving said report and endorsing all transfers thereof.

IN RE: WELFARE DEPARTMENT

Mrs. King B. Talley appeared before the Board and presented an application for state and local hospitalization with the recommendation that it be denied.

Upon motion of Mr. Tunstall, seconded by Mr. Winn the Board unanimously denied this request.

IN RE: REGIONAL JUVENILE COURT - ENDORSED

Mrs. Talley discussed with the Board the possibility of the County participating in a regional juvenile court. (At this time Mr. Smith became sick and turned the meeting over to Mr. Winn and left the room). The Board gave its endorsement to Mrs. Talley's proposal of a regional juvenile court.

IN RE: WELFARE DEPARTMENT BUDGET 1971-72 - APPROVED

Upon motion of Mr. Tunstall, seconded by Mr. Watkins the Board unanimously approved the welfare budget in the amount of \$238,700.00. Of this budget the County will pay \$31,500.00. (At this time Mr. Smith returned to the room and resumed the chair).

IN RE: BUILDING INSPECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Blaha presented a report to the Board and stated that building had doubled for the 1st 3 months of 1971 over 1970.

IN RE: ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION

Mr. A. W. Chappell presented his monthly report and 2 claims to the Board.

Upon motion of Mr. Watkins, seconded by Mr. Winn the Board unanimously agreed to pay \$36.00 for two lambs belonging to James G. Flowers.

Upon motion of Mr. Watkins, seconded by Mr. Winn the Board unanimously agreed to pay \$5.00 for 5 chickens belonging to Jacequelin Spiers.

IN RE: SHOOTING RANGE PERMIT - J. E. BOWLES

Mr. J. E. Bowles' application for a shooting range permit was presented for final approval. Mr. Bowles' application having been filed with the Board at the meeting held March 3, 1971.

Upon motion of Mr. Winn, seconded by Mr. Tunstall the Board unanimously approved the shooting range permit for the year 1971.

IN RE: SHOOTING RANGE PERMIT - INTRODUCED - CHAPPELL LEE

A shooting range permit application was introduced to the Board for Mr. Chappell Lee.

Action will be taken at the May 5th meeting.

IN RE: REPAIRS TO THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUILDING ROOF

Upon motion of Mr. Winn, seconded by Mr. Tunstall the Board unanimously approved the repairs to the Health Building roof and authorized the Executive Secretary to contract to have the job completed.

IN RE: HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Mr. R. V. Lancaster, III and Mr. B. C. Medlock, representing the Highway Department appeared before the Board.

DARVILLS DISTRICT:

Mr. Cabel Bishop representing the users of Route 691 and the property owners adjacent to Route 691 presented a petition bearing the signatures of these people to the Board requesting hard surfacing of State Route 691.

Upon motion of Mr. Winn, seconded by Mr. Tunstall the Board unanimously recommended to the Highway Department that this request be granted.

ROHOIC DISTRICT:

Mr. Howard Edwards representing a group of land owners along Confererate Avenue requested the Board of Supervisors to take this road into the Highway System. Mr. Lancaster stated that this should be taken up with the Roadviewers and that appropriate action would be taken after their recommendation.

Upon motion of Mr. Tunstall, seconded by Mr. Winn the Board unanimously recommended to the Highway Department that this request be granted.

SAPONY DISTRICT:

Mr. Hinton King presented a petition bearing 13 signatures to the Board of Supervisors requesting that State Route 692 be hard surfaced.

Upon motion of Mr. Tunstall, seconded by Mr. Winn the Board unanimously recommended that this request be granted.

Mr. Tunstall requested that site improvements along Route 619 in both Sapony and Rowanty District be made.

NAMOZINE DISTRICT:

Mr. Lottie Williams requested hard surfacing of State Route 690.

No action was taken.

Mr. Lancaster explained to all the groups that their requests will be given consideration but no promises could be made for action at this time. Action depended upon road count and availability of money.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board the meeting adjourned at 3:45 P.M.
