IN RE: -AWARDING \$700,000 SCHOOL BONDS TO VIRGINIA PUBLIC SCHOOL  
AUTHORITY

The County Administrator reported to the Board of Supervisors that the best bid received by the Virginia Public School Authority for the purchase of \$20,000,000 of its bonds called for a net interest cost of 4.8659% and that the Authority has offered to purchase at a price of par and accrued interest the \$700,000 School Bonds, Series of 1972, of Dinwiddie County at an interest rate of 4.95% per year for bonds maturing in the years 1972 to 1992, inclusive.

Upon motion of Mr. Tunstall, seconded by Mr. Rundle, the following resolution was adopted by the following roll call vote, the ayes and nays being recorded in the minutes of the meeting as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DINWIDDIE COUNTY, VIRGINIA, that the \$700,000 School Bonds, Series of 1972, of Dinwiddie County, the form and details of which have heretofore been and the same are hereby sold to the Virginia Public School Authority at a price of par and accrued interest from the date of the bonds to the date of delivery and shall bear interest at the rate of 4.95% per year for bonds maturing in the years 1973 to 1992, inclusive.

IN RE: SCHOOL BILL - PETERSBURG


IN RE: DINWIDDIE COUNTY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

Mr. Robert L. Mengel, Fire Chief, and Mr. Joseph F. Lewis appeared before the Board to present plans of the new fire department building. These plans indicated a reduction in the cost of the building below \$30,000.00. The Chairman told Mr. Mengel and Mr. Lewis that due to the absence of 2 members of the Board that no official action would be taken today, but, asked them to come back at the August 2nd meeting. In addition, they should meet with the Health Department to test the two sites discussed for drainfields and report back at the August meeting.
