IN RE: DISCUSSION OF SIX-YEAR PLAN -- SECONDARY ROADS SYSTEM FOR DINWIDDIE COUNTY

The Board of Supervisors met with Mr. C.B. Perry, II Resident Engineer, VDH&T, and Mr. B.C. Medlock, Assistant Resident Engineer, to discuss the proposed six-year plan for the Secondary Roads System for Dinwiddie County. This plan will be revised every two years.

Mr. Perry also reviewed Special Needs Improvements which the Department felt were critical areas in Dinwiddie County needing attention beyond the Secondary System allocation.

Mr. C.B. Perry, II, Resident Engineer, advised the Board that a public hearing must be held on the six-year plan for Secondary Roads and it must be revised and adopted by December 31, 1977. 
