IN RE: MASTER PLAN OF PETERSBURG AIRPORT--PRESENTATION BY DEWBERRY, NEALON & DAVIS

Mr. Jim McCormick, Dewberry, Nealon & Davis, presented an Executive Summary of the Petersburg Municipal Airport Master Plan Study, highlighting the major sections.

He stated that Dinwiddie County's main concern in relation to the Airport development would be the land use control surrounding the property and the effects of future industry locating in the proposed industrial park. Additional land or easements should be acquired by the City along Route 460 W in order to meet the safety standards set by the FAA.
