IN RE: DISCUSSION OF 1980-81 SCHOOL BOARD BUDGET


Dr. R.L. Vaughn, Superintendent of Schools, appeared before the Board to review the 1980-81 School Board budget and answer any questions they might have.

Mr. Bill Trinkle appeared before the Board to review the present Recreation program and present a recommendation for expansion of the program for the Board's consideration. The expansion would require a budget of \$20,000.

Mr. Weber requested that if the budget had to be reduced, the School Board find areas other than teacher salaries to make the reductions. Mr. Frank Freudig, President of the DEA, stated that the Dinwiddie Education Association, representing 252 teachers, endorsed the school board budget as presented.
