IN RE: ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

Upon motion of Mr. Robertson, seconded by Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Weber, voting "aye", Mr. Clay abstaining, Mr. A.S. Clay was elected Chairman of the Board for the year 1981 or until his duly elected successor assumes office.

IN RE: ELECTION OF VICE-CHAIRMAN

Upon motion of Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mr. Weber, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Weber, Mr. Clay voting "aye", Mr. Robertson abstaining, Mr. G.E. Robertson, Jr. was elected Vice-Chairman of the Board for the year 1981 or until his duly elected successor assumes office.

Upon motion of Mr. Robertson, seconded by Mr. Weber, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Weber, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Clay voting "aye", the minutes of the December 17, 1980 meeting were approved as presented.

IN RE: CLAIMS

Upon motion of Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mr. Robertson, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Weber, Mr. Clay voting "aye",

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County, Virginia that the following claims be approved:

IN RE: TREASURER

Mrs. Margaret W. Lewis presented her report for the month of December, 1980. Mr. Robertson asked how taxes were coming in. Mrs. Lewis stated as of December 5, 1980, 84.5% were in, which was about 1% less than last year. Mr. Robertson also asked if Mrs. Lewis had received any delinquent taxes as a result of running the delinquent list in the paper. She stated she had received \$7,000 and she felt that \$5,000 was as a result of the ad that was run. The list of remaining uncollected 1977 taxes has gone to the Clerk's Office for the Board's action.

IN RE: DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL SERVICES

Mrs. King B. Talley appeared before the Board to give a brief update on the Fuel Allocation Program. She stated that due to a computer problem, the payment of checks has been held up; however, she hoped that it had been corrected and checks would be going out shortly.

IN RE: CHANGES IN PRIMARY SYSTEMS DUE TO RELOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION ON RT. 460

Upon motion of Mr. Robertson, seconded by Mr. Weber, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Weber, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Clay voting "aye", the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Primary Route 460, From 6.542 Mi. E. Dinwiddie-Nottoway C.L. to 1.406 Mi. E. Dinwiddie-Nottoway C.L., a distance of 5.136 miles, has been altered, and a new road has been constructed and approved by the State Highway Commissioner, which new road serves the same citizens as the road so altered; and

WHEREAS, certain sections of this new road follow new locations, these being shown on the attached sketch titled, "Changes in Secondary System Due to Relocation and Construction on Route 460, Project 6460-026-104, C508, C505 dated at Richmond, Virginia 11-5-80".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County, Virginia that the portions of Secondary Route 639, i.e., Section 2, shown in brown on the sketch titled, "Changes in Secondary System Due to Relocation and Construction on Route 460, Project 6460-026-104, C508, C505 dated at Richmond, Virginia 11-5-80", a total distance of 0.08 miles be, and hereby is, added to the Secondary System of State Highways, pursuant to Section 33.141 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 as amended; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County, Virginia that the sections of old location, i.e., Section 1, shown in green on the afore-mentioned sketch, a total distance of 0.19 miles, be, and the same hereby is, abandoned as a public road, pursuant to Section 33-76.12 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 as amended.

IN RE: EXECUTIVE SESSION

Upon motion of Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mr. Robertson, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Weber, Mr. Clay voting "aye", the Board moved into Executive Session at 2:15 P.M. to discuss legal and personnel matters. The meeting reconvened into open session at 2:57 P.M.

IN RE: VA. DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS & TRANSPORTATION

Mr. B.C. Medlock, Assistant Resident Engineer, VDH&T, appeared before the Board to answer any questions they might have.

1. Mr. Medlock advised the Board that work on the Bobbitt Road was almost complete and the Board should again meet to establish priorities for the next rural addition.

2. In discussing rural additions, Mr. Robertson asked what would be needed to complete Rt. 615 to connect it with Rt. 670. Mr. Medlock advised the Board that obtaining the needed right-of-ways between Rt. 615 and Rt. 670 was the only thing holding them up.

Upon motion of Mr. Robertson, seconded by Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Weber, Mr. Clay voting "aye", the County Administrator was authorized to take the necessary action to obtain the right-of-ways needed by the VDH&T to allow the construction of that portion of the road needed to connect Rt. 615 with Rt. 670.

3. Mr. Medlock asked what the Board wanted to do with West Drive. He stated he didn't want to see it dropped at this point as he thought from the way the deed read that possibly the County might already own or could rightfully take the property in question. He further advised the Board to ask the County Attorney to review the deed.

The County Administrator stated that he had tried on several occasions to contact the attorney working with the case, Steve White, but was not successful. He said he would try to talk with him in person before the February 4, 1980 meeting.

4. Mr. Robertson asked what the time frame was for completing the project at the intersection of Rt. 600 and Rt. 226. Mr. Medlock stated he hoped it would be completed this year, probably after July. Mr. Robertson also asked about the Southern Pines project. Mr. Medlock stated that should be complete before July, 1981.

5. Mr. Weber asked Mr. Medlock to check on repairing the entrance to Rt. 714 off U.S. #1 where a large piece of the pavement has been knocked out.

6. Mr. Hargrave asked what the possibility was of having the stop sign at the intersection of Rt. 619 and U.S. #1 changed to a Yield sign. Mr. Medlock stated that all secondary roads fronting on or leading into a primary road must have a stop sign according to present regulations.

IN RE: ADJOURNMENT

Upon motion of Mr. Robertson, seconded by Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Robertson, Mr. Hargrave, Mr. Weber, Mr. Clay voting "aye", the meeting adjourned at 3:25 P.M.
