

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**Dinwiddie County Acknowledges Field Day of the Past's  
Announcement and Emphasizes Compliance with Local Regulations**

DINWIDDIE, VA - Dinwiddie County acknowledges the recent public announcement by Field Day of the Past regarding their intent to relocate their annual event from Amelia County to Dinwiddie County. While we share in the excitement surrounding the possibility of hosting this well-known event, it is important to clarify that no formal approvals or permits have been issued for its operation in the County.

County officials have been in communication with Field Day of the Past representatives and remain committed to working with them through the proper permitting and regulatory processes. The organization has expressed interest in hosting a one-time event this September, followed by an application for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to establish a permanent location. Any such application will be subject to a comprehensive review, public hearings, and an opportunity for citizen input before the Dinwiddie County Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors.

“Our priority is to ensure that any large-scale event or land use change aligns with County ordinances, maintains public safety, and respects the interests of all Dinwiddie residents - both those who support the event and those who may have concerns,” said W. Kevin Massengill, County Administrator. “We look forward to working with the event organizers to ensure they follow the proper procedures, allowing for transparency, community engagement, and a fair review process.”

Dinwiddie County encourages all residents to stay informed and participate in the upcoming discussions regarding Field Day of the Past. Additional details on public hearings and opportunities for input will be shared as the process moves forward.

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
