

LEAD Well Summit Scheduled in Dinwiddie County

DINWIDDIE, VA – Dinwiddie County’s Faith-Based Initiative has joined forces, once again with local government and school leaders to host the third LEAD Well Summit. This event, brings together leaders from all facets of the community – faith, government, schools, business, civic, and non-profit – in an effort to coordinate practices that will lead to a stronger, healthier community for all County citizens.

Regarding the Faith-Based Initiative, County Administrator, W. Kevin Massengill stated, “In 2018, Dinwiddie County and Dinwiddie County Public Schools recognized that in order to achieve the maximum level of success for all of our citizens, we need to look beyond the traditional scope of government and schools; moving outside our offices and classrooms to work directly in the communities we serve.” Massengill continued, “This will be our third LEAD Well Summit. The first focused on servant leadership, the second focused on the power of influence and this year’s Summit theme is “Faith, Family, Forward”.

Pastor Jonathan Alexis of Vision Church shared, “Our planning committee has designed a variety of exciting breakout sessions in an effort to address the specific needs of our community and ignite a passion for Faith, Family, and service moving Forward.”
