County Hires First-Ever County Engineer

DINWIDDIE, VA – The Dinwiddie County Board of Supervisors is pleased to announce Frank Haltom as the County Engineer.

Mr. Haltom, a licensed professional engineer since 2001, earned his bachelor’s degree in civil engineering from the Virginia Military Institute. He began his career in the private sector and gained valuable experience designing new infrastructure to support residential and commercial developments throughout the state.

Mr. Haltom began his public service in 2009 as the Assistant Director of General Services for Isle of Wight County, where he was later appointed as the Director of the department. Most recently, Mr. Haltom served as Director of Engineering and Utilities for Prince George County since 2018. In these roles, he planned and developed new infrastructure to support each County’s strategic goals.

Regarding his new role, Mr. Haltom shared, “I am excited about the opportunity to serve as the County Engineer and support Dinwiddie County in their efforts to enhance the quality of life for its citizens.”
