With eight years of service to the Sheriff's Office, Sergeant D.C. Williams is well known amongst his peers and citizens as being active in the community. D.C. received media attention in 2016 after a citizen captured a photo of him purchasing a hot meal for a homeless citizen and posted it to Facebook. While this occurrence was captured and shared, this was not an isolated incident. D.C. has assisted less fortunate citizens in similar situations before.

In addition to serving the citizens of Dinwiddie County, D.C. serves his fellow co-workers and peers in other agencies by sharing his knowledge and expertise of law enforcement and technology through training. He serves as an instructor at Crater Criminal Justice Academy, provides instruction to others on the use of OC Spray, and actively assists others in the use of their MDTs (computers utilized in patrol vehicles). D.C. took an active role in the implementation of the Sheriff's office use of body cameras and is currently assisting with the development of an electronic summoning process that will add efficiencies to the Sheriff's office and courts.
