## County Schedules Reopening

DINWIDDIE, VA – In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Dinwiddie County government offices and facilities have been closed to the public since March 25, 2020. The Commonwealth of Virginia has now entered Phase 2 of reopening, therefore Dinwiddie County will begin remobilization on June 15, 2020.

Effective **Monday, June 15, 2020** the following Dinwiddie County facilities will be **OPEN** to the public, per their normal operating schedules:

- ✓ Animal Control
- ✓ Courthouse
- ✓ Eastside Community Enhancement Center
- ✓ Government Center
- ✓ Information Technology
- ✓ Landfill
- ✓ Manned Convenience Sites
- ✓ McKenney Gym
- ✓ Pamplin Building
- ✓ Public Safety
- ✓ Robert & Betty Ragsdale Community Center
- ✓ Sports Complex

The following Dinwiddie County facilities will remain **CLOSED** to the public until further notice:

- ✗ Fire Stations
- ✗ Historic Dinwiddie Courthouse

Regarding reopening, County Administrator W. Kevin Massengill stressed “The health and safety of citizens and employees continues to be our top priority. Our plan for reopening and

remobilization has been carefully developed with this in mind. We ask patrons to ‘Do the 5’ when visiting County facilities.” These five steps include:

1. FEEL – Sick? Stay Home.
2. ELBOW – Cough into it.
3. FACE – Wear a mask.
4. FEET – Stand at least 6 feet apart.
5. HANDS – Wash them often.
