Electoral Board Appoints New General Registrar

DINWIDDIE, VA – The Dinwiddie County Electoral Board has appointed Stephanie B. Wray as the County’s next General Registrar. Mrs. Wray will assume the position on December 1, 2020 following the retirement of current General Registrar, Linda Brandon, on November 30, 2020.

Linda Brandon began working part-time in the Registrar’s office in November 2001 and was sworn in as General Registrar for Dinwiddie County in February 2002. At the time of her retirement she will have facilitated voting for five Presidential elections and countless state and local elections and primaries. Ms. Effie Moore, Secretary of the Dinwiddie County Electoral Board shared, “Mrs. Brandon has served Dinwiddie County and its citizens well during her 19 years with the office. Under her leadership, voting in Dinwiddie County has been a smooth and challenge-free process. We wish her all the best in retirement.”

Mrs. Wray, who will begin working with the General Registrar on October 15, 2020, will be sworn into the position on December 1, 2020. She holds a Bachelor’s degree in Business Administration from Virginia Commonwealth University. Mrs. Wray began her career with Dinwiddie County in 2013 as Accounting Technician in the Finance Department. In 2014 she moved into the position of Executive Assistant to the County Administrator and Clerk to the Board of Supervisors, where she will remain until her transition to the Registrar’s Office next month. Mrs. Wray is a resident of Dinwiddie County and is active in the community. She was named Employee of the Month in April 2016, and was the recipient of the County’s 2019 Recognition & Excellence Award for Volunteerism for her work with the Dinwiddie Kiwanis Club. She completed coursework and was certified as a Municipal Clerk in January 2018.

Regarding Mrs. Wray’s appointment, Ms. Moore stated, “We welcome Mrs. Wray and look forward to working with her as General Registrar. We are grateful for her opportunity to work alongside Mrs. Brandon through the upcoming General Election. This on-the-job training will be invaluable to her new role as General Registrar.”
