County Community Centers Set Up to Provide Support with Virtual Learning

The Dinwiddie County Department of Parks and Recreation has established space in the Eastside Community Enhancement Center and the Robert & Betty Ragsdale Community Center where families can safely participate in virtual learning.

Each facility has designated rooms specifically to support internet needs for virtual learning students. Each room will include socially distanced tables and work areas for students and seating at each desk for a parent/s. Students will have access to Guest WiFi at each facility. Tables and chairs will be sanitized after each use.

Rooms will be open from 9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Students must provide their own device (Chromebook, laptop, tablet, etc.) and any additional supplies needed to participate in virtual learning. Students must be supervised by a parent or guardian at ALL times in community centers. Parents and students must adhere to COVID-19 guidelines for public facilities, to include wearing a mask or face covering at all times while in the community centers, and patrons will be required to sign in and out at the reception desk when using the rooms.
