## County Launches COVID-19 Grant Programs for Local Non-Profit Organizations

**DINWIDDIE, VA** – The Dinwiddie County Board of Supervisors recently approved two COVID-19 grant programs for non-profit organizations located in and serving Dinwiddie County.

Through the County’s CARES Act allocation, the Board set aside \$200,000 to fund grants to churches and other eligible local non-profits, to mitigate the impact of COVID-19 on daily operations. The Board also allocated funding to distribute Defogging Kits to local churches and non-profits with a reimbursement provision for those organizations that have already purchased these items.

Deputy County Administrator, Tammie J. Collins, stated “Now more than ever, citizens depend on our faith-based community and non-profits for support. Through these grant programs, our goal is to provide assistance that will allow these organizations to fulfill their missions safely and effectively during the pandemic.”

Dan Lee, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shared, “Dinwiddie County is very fortunate to have a robust faith and non-profit community, dedicated to serving those in need. These grant programs represent our commitment to supporting these organizations as they provide critical support to our citizens.”
