Landfill Hours

Monday – Saturday, 7 am – 7 pm
Sunday, 1 pm – 7 pm

- Dinwiddie County was significantly impacted by a winter storm over the weekend. The volume of vegetative/woody debris is more than can be processed at manned convenience sites.
- Vegetative/woody debris will **ONLY** be accepted by the **Dinwiddie County Landfill**.
- Vegetative/woody debris will be accepted by the Landfill at **NO CHARGE**.
- The landfill **DOES NOT** accept stumps, root balls, or hazardous materials.
- Landfill staff may weigh vehicles used to haul debris. This will be used for volume calculations only.
- Contractors transporting winter storm-related debris will be charged regular Landfill fees.
