

At the regular meeting of the County School Board of Dinwiddie County, Virginia, held at Dinwiddie, Virginia on October 12, 1965, the following resolution was adopted:


WHEREAS, the County School Board of Dinwiddie County is of the opinion that it is necessary to make the school improvements hereinafter described and to expend therefor the sum of \$1,000,000.00 in addition to any other moneys available to finance the cost of such school improvements; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED by the County School Board of Dinwiddie County, as follows:

(1) The Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County is hereby requested to request the Circuit Court of Dinwiddie County to order an election upon the question of contracting a debt in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 by the issuance of bonds of Dinwiddie County, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Borrowing Law of 1952 of Virginia, or amendments thereto, and/or the Virginia Public School Authority Act of 1962, and/or any other method of financing that the governing body would desire to finance the cost of school improvements in said County, including the purchase of sites for school buildings, building school buildings, or additions to school buildings, and the furnishing and equipping of new and existing school buildings or additions to school buildings, and making other improvements to the school system at Dinwiddie County.

(2) The Clerk of the County School Board is hereby directed to present a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County at the meeting of the said Board of Supervisors on October 13, 1965.

IN RE: TRAILER PERMIT MR. & MRS. WILLIE S. RIDEOUT.


